Operation Showers of Appreciation is proud to announce our first military baby shower at Fort Bragg, NC. The shower will be at 301 N. Dougherty Dr. (Corregidor Courts/Bougainville Neighborhood Center) at 2pm on Saturday January 21st.

To be eligible for our January 21st shower you must:

- Be expecting ONLY between February 1st, 2012-May 31st, 2012. Those expecting in June of 2012 or later will not be considered.
- Be an active duty service woman or spouse of an enlisted man with rank of E1-E5. Higher ranking individuals and officers will not be considered.
- Be living at or near Fort Bragg, NC. Those living in another state will not be considered.

As part of the online registration form you will be requested to upload a copy of your LES and your [Verification Form](#) which must be signed off by the service members' supervisor. We will accept online registrations for our January 21st shower up until December 5th. Those moms who have been chosen for our January 21st shower will be notified by December 15th via e-mail.

Submitting an application for assistance does not guarantee you will be selected to participate in an Operation Showers of Appreciation Baby Shower. Families are selected to participate based on the following:

- Due Date
- Date Completed Application for Assistance Received
- Information provided in the "Tell us about your family" section
- Rank

Info: This shower will be extremely small so we encourage everyone to apply ASAP. If you are selected for the shower you will be allowed to bring up to 3 additional guests (including older children). You will also be requested to bring your Military ID and a vehicle with a large trunk.
